Coronavirus: Woodcarver makes superhero plaques for NHS

The BBC has reported that a wood carver has hand-carved plaques to show appreciation for the NHS. **Johnathon Whittaker**, a full-time wood carver and sculptor from Devon, said he received over 4,000 requests for the plaques from NHS staff.

The requests were consolidated and then donated into deliveries for 67 hospitals. He said if his designs made staff feel "more appreciated at the end of a long shift, it's the least I can do".

A Royal Devon and Exeter Foundation Trust (RD&E FT) spokesman said "[Ours] is now sitting proudly in our main reception for all to see." (See below.)



CRAFT DEEP GROOVES, V SLOTS, CURVE PATTERNS & LINES


Old Jokes Home:

The District of Hope, Alaska. Carved Sign. Let us hope we are all in the 'District of Hope' once the vaccination programme gains momentum.


